 - As an observer to the EWG on the review of the Basel annexes (RA-4), FEAD will take part in the fourth meeting of the EWG on 1-3 February 2021. The session will

resume from October's meeting and will continue the work on the review of Annex IV and the e-waste entries A 1180 and B1110 (Annex VIII and IX). The EWG is expected to exchange views on amendment proposals received from the EU and Ghana & Switzerland. In preparation of the meeting, parties have been asked to share views on 8 issues related to Annex IV.

Monitoring of EU Institutions

Life of EU institutions

 The European Parliament's Environment Committee will hold an exchange of views with the Portuguese Minister of Environment and Climate Action, Mr João Pedro Matos Fernandes, during their committee meeting of 25 January. The debate will focus on the priorities of the Portuguese Council Presidency for the next six months.

This week's focus: new Plastic Waste Entries

- Following the publication of the delegated act implementing into the WSR the new Basel Convention amendments (22 December), the new plastic waste entries have entered into force as of 1 January 2021. The Commission, supporting the EU Correspondents' meeting, is currently working on a non-binding guideline to provide clarity on some terminology used in the amendments.
- FEAD had been asked to provide feedback on the matter in December 2020. The main issue identified is a 2% impurity threshold to comply with the wording "almost free from contamination". The latter does not seem practicable for the

waste management and recycling industry and FEAD is actively engaging in discussions with members and European partners to **highlight the need for higher thresholds to ensure the proper functioning of the recycling market**.

- Some updates:
 - While a relatively small number of MS have internally agreed on the implementation of a 2% threshold (Austria, The Netherlands), most MS are still conducting national consultation with stakeholders to understand how to find a % that would better suit the proper functioning of markets. No agreement has been reached at this stage.
 - The Commission is mainly focused on a single threshold (not differentiated by flow) as of easier enforcement. It also seems that the Commission will further engage in consultations to understand how to find a suitable solution to the wording "almost free from contamination".
 - FEAD is organising a Sub-Committee Shipments meeting on 26 January 2021, at 14:30-15:30 CET, to discuss a common FEAD strategy on the issue. An e-invite will follow soon.

- ZWE study on reusable packaging
 - The civil society organization Zero Waste Europe (ZWE) published a new <u>study</u> (December 2020) entitled "REUSABLE Vs SINGLE-USE PACKAGING: A review of environmental impacts" and finding that reusable packaging has 85% lower carbon emissions than singleuse alternatives.
