## **Communication, Networking and Future Events**

# **Ongoing Surveys and Consultations**

- <u>Target Revision of the Regulation on CLP</u>
  - The Commission opened a Public Consultation on the Targeted Revision of the Regulation on Classification, Labelling and Packaging of Substances and Mixtures (CLP) (here).

# • Environmental impact of photovoltaic modules, inverters, and systems:

- The Commission is opened a Public Consultation on the Roadmap for the environmental impact of photovoltaic modules, inverters, and systems (here).
- FEAD would like to know if we should give feedback on the need for a legislative action. Please provide us with your feedback by the 25<sup>th</sup> of October.

## General Block Exemption Regulation (GBER):

- 6<sup>th</sup> October, the Commission has opened the public consultation on the <u>draft General Block Exemption</u> <u>Regulation (GBER)</u>.
- It widens up the scope of existing provisions on aid for recycling and re-utilisation of waste, by also covering investment aid for other investments that aim at increasing the level of resource efficiency or contributing to the transition towards a circular economy.
- FEAD is preparing a draft response and send it to members in the upcoming days.

# • FEAD provided feedback to consultations:

18<sup>th</sup> October 2021: FEAD provided <u>feedback to the</u>
 <u>Correspondent's Guidelines No 12 on the classification</u>
 <u>of plastic waste</u>.

FEAD attended the 41st CARACAL Meeting CLP Delegated Acts (18th ATP). Certain substances of the list of entries to be included in Annex VI of CLP (RAC recommendations for harmonised classifications 2020) was open for discussion by members and observers. 39 new entries and 17 modified entries were recommended by RAC for inclusion in Annex VI, Part 3 of CLP. One existing entry is replaced by two new ones and will be deleted. Commented substances were among others, NH4Br, DTPA, Divanadium pentoxide, V2O5, Melamine, HMDZ-treated SAS.

## **Monitoring of EU Institutions**

### **Life of EU institutions**

## • Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment:

 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021: The Commission presented a Report on the exercise of power to adopt delegated acts under EU rules on the collection of waste from electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE).

#### • End-of-Life Vehicles:

 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021: The co-legislators did not respond to the Commission's Staff Working Document on the evaluation of the End-of-life Vehicles Directive.

## • Recovery of Waste in Non-OECD Countries:

 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021: The Commission Regulation amends Commission Regulation (EC) No 1418/2007 concerning the export of recovery of certain waste to certain non-OECD countries. It provides an updated list of non-OECD countries where waste can be exported for recovery under EU rules on waste shipments.

## • Sewage Sludge Directive:

 21<sup>st</sup> October 2021: The Commission amended the draft Implementing Decision by updating the format for reporting. Furthermore the Waste Technical Adaptation Committee have been made available the <u>minutes</u> of the meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

# • Commission Work Programme 2022:

- 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021: The <u>Commission Work Programme</u>
  2022 was presented.
- In its Work Programme, the Commission confirmed its intention on several topics:

- present a measure addressing the release of microplastics in the environment during the last quarter of 2022
- present a Communication to establish a policy framework for biobased, biodegradable or compostable plastics during the second quarter of 2022
- merge the revision of the ELVs Directive with the revision of 3R Type-Approval Directive on the typeapproval of motor vehicles with regard to their reusability, recyclability.

## Waste Framework Directive: Average Loss Rates:

 The Council has extended the period for raising objections to the Commission's Delegated Decision on the calculation, verification and reporting of the weight of materials removed and not recycled after sorting, based on average loss rates by 2 months.

#### • Waste Batteries:

 18<sup>th</sup> October 2021: The revision of the Batteries and Accumulators Directive casts doubts on the adoption of additional requirements for the treatment and recycling of waste batteries out of the EU. The Commission is unlikely to adopt additional requirements.

# • Monitoring Framework for a circular economy:

 15<sup>th</sup> October 2021: The Commission is expected to present a revised monitoring framework for a circular economy. In particular, the revised monitoring framework would improve interlinkages between circularity, climate neutrality and the zero-pollution ambition.
